Presentation material

During the meeting a ppt presentation was used containing information that was sent out prior to the meeting. The minutes from the Evaluation Team meeting @ SU on February 28th were also sent out prior to the meeting and were referred to during the meeting.

Minutes

1. Christer opened the meeting by welcoming everyone to the 16th Steering Committee meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were then briefly reviewed and action items will be covered during the meeting.

2. Progress Report

Events & Activities

- The **SIREUS ENTREPREURS forum** was held during the week of March 18th, 2024, in Colorado. Nicole Forsberg from CU Boulder & SACC CO was the host together with SIREUS staff. UU, LU, SU, MDU and LIU were participating at the forum and had 6 of "their" companies attending and presenting.
- The SIREUS MEMBERS forum in conjunction with the NAFSA 2024 conference in New Orleans is in the final stage of planning.
- The first **SIREUS RESEARCH forum** was held on December 11th @ 16:30 CET and had 60 participants, the second SIREUS RESEARCH forum was held on January 24th @ 16:30 and had 48 participants and the third was held on March 4th @ 16:30 and had 56 participants. SIREUS is planning the coming forums continuously and planning to focus on funding for researchers.
- More activities in Social Media are being planned, not only in conjunction with events. There is a request to also promote individual universities.

3. SIREUS <u>Decision</u> / <u>Discussion</u> / <u>Information</u>

Financial Report

Christer presented the financial report for March 2024 and emphasized that there are no surprises compared with the budget.

SIREUS 2.0 Evaluation

Christer referred to the previous meeting and the process for the Evaluation. The meeting today will focus on discussing the recommendation from the Evaluation Team.

Prior to the meeting the Minutes from the meeting @ SU on February 28th was referenced. Please review the document in its entirety to get a complete picture.

Some of the feedback can be summarized as.

- 1. SIREUS Platform to ambitious for the resources allocated at universities.
- 2. Lack of government funding => not sustainable operation
- 3. Difficult to satisfy all => workgroup participation is not always highest priority
 - Larger vs. smaller universities
 - Focus on Talent Mobility vs Innovation/Research
 - Different universities have different maturity for their US Strategy

After a summary of the feedback, Christer answered some questions and then summarized the recommendation from the Evaluation Team.

- 1. SIREUS 2.0 More focused, fewer meetings, focus on events and open up the network. > ~10 universities need to join to form a network.
- 2. Only focus on Study-in-Sweden events. Not enough substance to have a network. SACC does not see it as strategic and would probably not be involved.
- 3. SIREUS will end after January 31st, 2025.

Christer went through the recommendation in detail as per the presentation and then the participants commented on the recommendation. Some questions were answered during the conversation and the conclusion is that most SIREUS MEMBERS need to digest the recommendation and will get back to Christer individually during the next month. Some of the universities referred to a change of priorities for the US, while others mentioned that they want to focus on either talent mobility or research & innovation.

Christer also mentioned that he has been in contact with Vinnova and other government organization and the conclusion is that with a focused approach in talent mobility and innovation, there is a better possibility to get funds from SI, Vinnova and others, for specific events and activities. They all emphasized that in order to get funding the SIREUS activities and events need to be "open" for other universities, although they might have to pay a fee for participation.

Christer also showed a preliminary financial outlook for different scenarios and emphasized that the funding for the project will be a challenge. He further mentioned that he has a parallel conversation with SACC-USA, whose board must approve an extension of the SIREUS project.

The Steering Committee thanked Margareta, Christer and the Evaluation Team for a good job and will get back to Christer with their decision in good time before the next meeting (May 28th, 2024).

4. AOB & Next meeting

Since there were no Other Business for the meeting, Christer thanked the participants for the meeting.

The next steering committee meeting will be held via Teams on May 28th @ 15.00 CET (9 am EST). The main topic of that meeting is to decide on the way forward for SIRUES 2.0
