Minutes

- 1. Christer opened the meeting by welcoming everyone to the 20th Steering Committee meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were then briefly reviewed and action items will be covered during the meeting.
- 2. Progress Report

Events & Activities

- SIREUS Study-in-Sweden tour on October 4th to 12th results
 - October 4th Washington DC (9 universities -15 rep)
 - 143 students registered 73 attended 70 alumni registered 27 attended
 - October 7th New York City (9 universities -15 rep)
 - 70 students registered 27 attended 63 alumni registered 26 attended
 - October 11th San Francisco (3 universities 6 rep)
 - 89 students registered 44 attended
 - October 12th Silicon Valley (2 universities 4 rep)
 - 30 alumni registered 12 attended
 - Strong Social Media push / Instagram boosting
 - DC (11,941 views/103 clicks), NYC (10,802 views/77 clicks, SF (8,901 views/82 clicks)
 - o Total costs (for SIREUS): \$17,552 USD. SI contributed \$15,500 USD!!!
 - o Both Student recruitment and alumni events.
 - o Feedback:
 - San Fransisco was great.
 - NYC was not worth it probably should not be included next year.
 - Recommend that not mix student and alumni event. Unless it is an alumni panel at the student recruitment event.

- Potential visits next year could include Minnesota and Chicago area. Try to find colleges that do not offer master's program, e.g. Gustavus Adolphus...
- SIREUS RESEARCH forum ("Research, Knowledge and Innovation")
 - Fifth RESEARCH forum on October 2nd,2024 Deep tech investment in the life science and human performance space
 - For 2025 and beyond, the SIREUS RESEARCH forum is planned to be led by Maria Brogren with support from SACC USA.
- **Finetuning the operation** and programs for 2025 and beyond.
 - o Preparing the transitional documents, website and articles to be published
 - Preparing to transition the operation to SACC-USA
 - 2 trainees will be 1 trainee in January 2025
 - Christer B will conclude his assignment by January 2025 (as per contract)
 - All activities will be operated by SACC-USA.
 - SIREUS financials will be included in the regular SACC-USA financial report.
 - Christer B will be supporting in a volunteer capacity on request from SACC-USA
 - SIREUS Programs
 - SIREUS ENTREPRENEURS forum March 2025, Denver & Boulder, CO
 - SIREUS MEMBERS forum May 28th 2025 in San Diego
 - Innovation Tour to be planned after request
 - Study-in-Sweden fall 2025 October/November 2025

3. SIREUS Decision / Discussion / Information

Financial Report

Christer presented the financial report for September 2024 and emphasized that there are no real surprises. By the end of the year, the SIREUS finances will be closed and for 2025 and beyond, the SIREUS financial will be fully incorporated in SACC USA financial reports.

SIREUS 2.0 Implementation

SIREUS Affiliation of Swedish Universities

Christer referred to the revised document of SIREUS Affiliation of Swedish Universities that is now finalized. He also talked about the preliminary MOU that was sent out to the steering committee members and some feedback he received. Mainly the feedback is regarding the time period for the MOU. Margareta Alfredsson and Christer will revise the preliminary MOU and send it out separately shortly after the meeting.

The affiliated members will have preferred pricing on SIREUS offered programs, possibility to direct programs to certain areas, firsthand contacts to other universities and other stakeholders and will get invitations to academic workshops and seminars.

As of today (November 5), 6 SIREUS members are positive to join the affiliation (JU, LiU,LIN,LU,MiUN and SU). 3 SIREUS members have opted to not join the affiliation (GU, MDU and UU) and 2 SIREUS members have not yet made any decision (Chalmers and LuTH).

Christer opened the conversation whether or not there is enough members to have a meaningful affiliation. The group emphasized that together we have to try to get other Swedish universities to join. Christer agreed and will send out a message to "all" other Swedish universities, including KTH and KI. He will communicate to the group to whom he has sent the message, and the group was willing to forward it to others, should there be any we missed.

Christer again emphasized that since the decision of the affiliation has been delayed, the transition process will be compressed and the SIREUS team is doing everything to accomplish a transparent and professional transition campaign.

Final Stakeholders Group Meeting

Christer informed the group that there is a planned last meeting with the Stakeholders Group on December 17th, but the invitation has not been sent out and he recommended that the meeting should be cancelled. He will send out a formal message to the Stakeholders Group (cc the Steering Committee) during December declaring the SIREUS initial project has finished and inform about the formation of the affiliation. Everyone agreed with the recommendation and will inform their members in the Stakeholders Group about the plan.

4. AOB & Next meeting

Since there were no Other Business for the meeting, Christer thanked the participants for the meeting.

The next steering committee meeting will be held via Teams on December 10th @ 15.00 CET (9 am EST). The main topic of that meeting is to update on the transition for the SIREUS network.

Christer reminded us about the dates for the steering committee meetings for the whole of 2024. Invites have been sent out.
