Introduction

Between November 2nd and 6th, SIREUS, in collaboration with 12 of its member universities, organized a Study in Sweden trip across three cities in the U.S. With great planning and extensive discussions between SIREUS and university representatives from working group 4 we paved the way for successful events in New York City, NY, Pullman, WA, and Orange, CA. Building on the experience gained from the successful Study in Sweden fair at the House of Sweden in Washington D.C. in November 2022, the decision was made to expand the fair to multiple cities this year. In summary, the three events collectively attracted 193 students in total. This investment reflects the commitment for promoting Swedish education and facilitating meaningful connections between prospective students and Swedish universities. Prior to the event, a focused marketing campaign was conducted on social media (Instagram, LinkedIn, Facebook and Eventbrite). The event was also promoted via direct email and relevant parts of the SACC network promoted the fair in their region. Greater details about the events can be found below.
